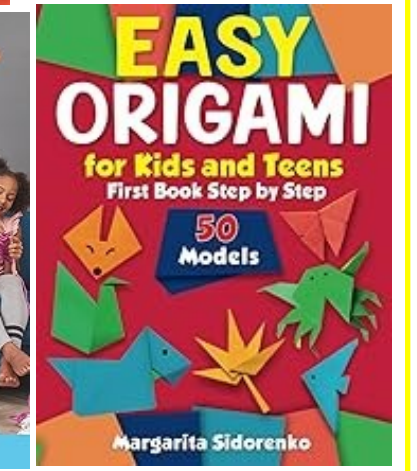
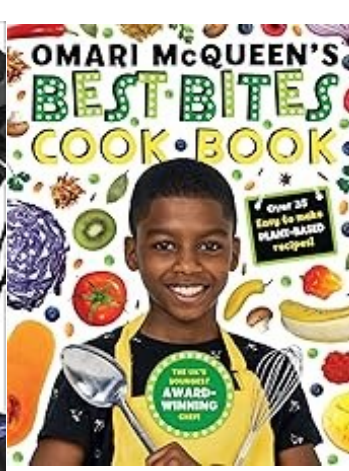
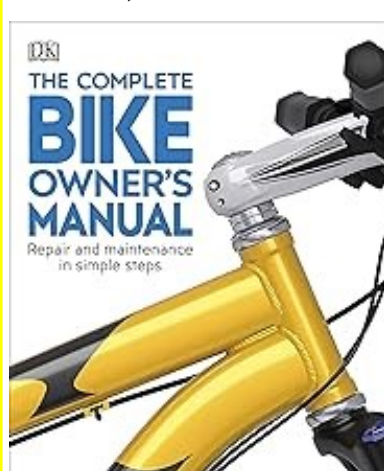
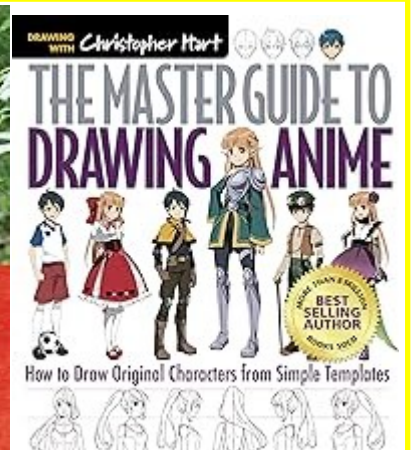
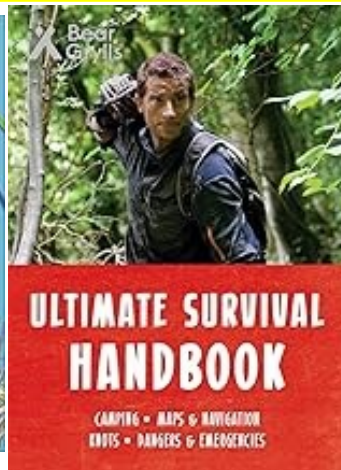
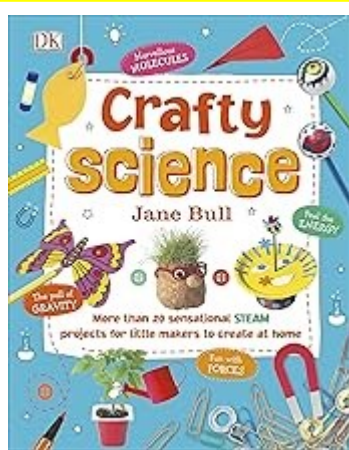


# REMEMBRANCE DAY RECOMMENDED READS
