























# NON FICTION NOVEMBER



You will be able to explore the book catalogue, find out what new books we have in, what books have been recently read, search for resources to help with homework, reserve books and write a book review.


You can also look up your account to see what you have borrowed and when they are due




# **MONTHLY LIBRARY CLUB FOCUS**

If you answered 'yes' to any of the above , then why not join Year 7 FILM CLUB.




