
We are looking forward to speaking to Luke Palmer, the Author of Carnegie shortlisted book 'Play' on the 29th April.

Once the students finish reading a book they write a book review on the 'Carnegies' webpage. You can see our shadowing groups book reviews so far by going onto to the link below.




It's simple! Every time a member of staff catches you reading a book (other than when

#### **Top Borrowing Tutor Group**











## SORA READING APP-FREE E-BOOKS & AUDIOBOOKS
